

CITY OF TENNESSEE RIDGE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

AUGUST 7, 2017 CITY HALL 6:00 P.M.

Mayor Odom called the meeting to order with the following commissioners present: Bryan Bumpus, Rebecca Hill and Kimberly Phillips. Ray Bradley arrived around 6:05 p.m. Also present were Nancy Cobb, Woodrow Adams, Kenneth Dunavant, Sid Vinson and Spencer Bryant.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Bryan Bumpus to accept the minutes of the previous meetings. Vote 4 Yes. Motion Passed.

Under old business the leak in the file room appears to be condensation and not a leak. Manager Dunavant is going to put a cap on a pipe that is above the ceiling tiles to see if that will fix the problem.

Also under old business the progress of the one-way street for McIntosh was discussed. It has not been made one way as of yet due to signs not being posted and coordination with the post office to move the mail boxes. With this discussion also came the discussion of something being done about the end of church street.

Manager Dunavant will update the board concerning the patching of certain city streets and get an estimate and bring it to the board at the next meeting.

Under new business the state has requested that a Drought Management Plan be adopted by the Tennessee Ridge Water Department.

Motion by Rebecca Hill, second by Ray Bradley to pass the Tennessee Ridge Drought Management Plan. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Second by Kim Phillips, second by Rebecca Hill to pass on first reading the passing of Ordinance #2017-197 for budget amendments to the 2017-2018 budget. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Manager Dunavant presented to the board three bids on a new utility truck for Tennessee Ridge. (Bid prices attached.)

Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Ray Bradley to accept the low bid for the 2500HD 4WD truck from James Corlew Chevrolet. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Bryan Bumpus to pass Resolution 2017-198R to enter into grant proceeding with Rural Development for 35% of the cost of the truck and snow plow that will be purchased in this fiscal year. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Rebecca Hill to change the next meeting date to the 11<sup>th</sup> of September due to the Labor Day weekend. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Rebecca Hill, second by Kim Phillips to adjourn. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.
