Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Ray Bradley to pass on second reading the budget amendment Ordinance #2017-197. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Rebecca Hill to place the patching of certain city street out for bid. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Ray Bradley to place the repair of the fire hall roof out for bids. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Ray Bradley, second by Kim Phillips to obtain bank rates to match the \$58,900.00 grant that the city received from an energy grant. Vote 5 Passed. Motion Passed.

As per information from Gary Jaeckel of MTAS, Nancy Cobb informed the board that the new law that was passed for commissioners to get trained, means the ones that get elected or re-elected after the date of the passing of the law.
