

CITY OF TENNESSEE RIDGE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

JANUARY 2, 2018 6:00 P.M. CITY HALL

Mayor Odom called the meeting to order with the following commissioners present: Bryan Bumpus, Kimberly Phillips, Rebecca Hill and Ray Bradley. Also present were Nancy Cobb, Woodrow Adams, Kenneth Dunavant and Sid Vinson. Jerry Bryant arrived a little later.

Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Ray Bradley to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Ray Bradley to pass on second reading the TOSHA Ordinance #2017-200. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Rebecca Hill, second by Kim Phillips to approve a Resolution honoring Jerry Lee Bryant for 46 years of service to the City of Tennessee Ridge. Vote 5 Yes.

Mayor Odom opened the floor to Mr. Kevin Smith from C I Thornburg to discuss the option of drive by meters. The units vary depending on the technology and warranty. The units cost approximately \$220.00 plus, per unit per meter. All Tennessee Ridge meters could be read by one person in two hours according to the rep. In addition to the equipment of the meters, there are additional costs that need to be considered as in Towers, radios and computer equipment. The estimated cost for a system for Tennessee Ridge would be in the area of \$500,000.

Jerry Bryant arrived at the meeting and the city board turned their attention to him, thanking him for his dedication to the city. He will be greatly missed by all.
