

CITY OF TENNESSEE RIDGE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

FEBRUARY 5, 2018 CITY HALL 6:00 P.M.

Mayor Odom called the meeting to order with the following commissioners present: Bryan Bumpus, Kimberly Phillips, Ray Bradley and Rebecca Hill. Also present were Kenneth Dunavant, Woodrow Adams, Nancy Cobb and Sid Vinson.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Rebecca Hill to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Kenneth Dunavant informed the board that the energy grant will not be started until around the first of March, 2018. Seth is backed up and will get to us as soon as possible.

Mr. Charles Claxton was at the board meeting to dispute a water bill that he had received in the mail. He informed the board that he thought that the meter was off. He did not feel that he was responsible for the 64,740 gallons in the amount of \$372.60.

Leslie Rucker informed the board that she had the work orders that stated Mr. Claxton wanted the meter left on, because he had work to do on the trailer. She had figured the adjusted amount to \$213.16 if the leak has been fixed.

Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Ray Bradley to approve not to charge Mr. Claxton for the water bills for the trailer. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Ray Bradley to pass on first reading an ordinance to ensure that from now on, the owner of the property, if they want it left on, they will need to sign the work order. If this work order is not signed, the meter will be locked. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Bryan Bumpus to pass on first reading Ordinance #2018-201 on budget amendments. For software and TOSHA. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Kenneth Dunavant updated the board on getting a replacement for Jerry Bryant. There are time limitations on getting a person in place and Kenneth is working on this.

Motion by Ray Bradley, second by Kim Phillips to adjourn. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.
