

CITY OF TENNESSEE RIDGE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

MAY 7, 2018 6:00 P.M. CITY HALL

Mayor Odom called the meeting to order with the following commissioners present: Bryan Bumpus, Ray Bradley and Kim Phillips. Also present were Woodrow Adams, Nancy Cobb, Sid Vinson, Andy Lemons and Kenneth Dunavant.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Bryan Bumpus to approve the previous meeting minutes. Vote 4 Yes. Motion Passed.

Mrs. Terri Bush came into the meeting and requested that something be done about the leak that has been in her yard for at least 2 years. Manager Dunavant stated that this has been a problem. Jerry Bryant feels that it is a leak on the old 2¼" Cast Iron pipe. When it is fixed they will have to shut down water for several customers. He stated that we will get together and see what can be done about this situation. We all feel that she has been patient with us on this problem in her yard.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Ray Bradley to pass on second reading to approve on second reading the money appropriated for the energy grant in the amount of \$117,000.00. Vote 4 Yes. Motion Passed. (First Passed on October 2, 2017)

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Bryan Bumpus to pass on first reading Ordinance #2018-205 for 2017-2018 Budget Amendments. Vote 4 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Bryan Bumpus, second by Kim Phillips to approve Ordinance #2018-206 raising the health insurance from \$375.00 to \$400.00 as of July 1, 2018. Vote 4 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Kim Phillips, second by Ray Bradley to approve Ordinance #2018-207 the 2018-2019 budget setting the tax rate at 75 cents per \$100. Assessed. Vote 4 Yes. Motion Passed.

Kenneth Dunavant introduced Andy Lemons to the council as the person that has been hired to be trained to be the water superintendent.

Motion by Ray Bradley, second by Kim Phillips to adjourn. Vote 4 Yes. Motion Passed.
