

CITY OF TENNESSEE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

October 1, 2018 6:00 p.m. City Hall

Mayor Odom called the meeting to order with the following members present: Ray Bradley, Mark Moore, Trent Hearndon and Kim Phillips. Also, present were Woodrow Adams, Kenneth Dunavant, Leslie Rucker, Seth Rye and Andy Lemons.

Motion by Ray Bradley, second by Trent Hearndon to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Motion by Mark Moore, second by Tent Hearndon to pass on first reading Ordinance #2018-209 for chemicals and lab fees. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.

Tim Planer spoke to the board concerning building codes for the city. He explained what the codes are for and what they are not for. Building fee is based on the value of home. The board has the option to opt in or opt out. The time frame for this is 180 days after an election. This has to pass by 2/3 vote of the board.

Seth Rye addressed the board to update several items. The tank inspection finding which has to be done every five years has been done. The old city hall tank needs painting on the inside. The newer Clearwell needs painting on the interior and exterior. Gray's Crossing tank does not need anything within the next five years; but it would need it in the next five years. The estimated cost of this would be \$500,000. Rural Development has money to lend at a reasonable rate. Also, allow for down time and purchases of water during the painting of the tanks.

The energy grant should be completed in the next few months.

The state is requiring an updated map for the city. The estimated cost of this would be \$2500.00

There will be a Hazard Mitigation meeting on October 9, 2018 at 1:30 P.M. at the City of Erin. A representative has been requested to be present.

Motion by Kim Phillips to adjourn, second by Mark Moore. Vote 5 Yes. Motion Passed.
